



A growing population emphasised the need for postage stamps. They finally materialised in 1878 with the issue of 1d. and 6d. stamps, printed by Bradbury, Wilkinson & Co Ltd in sheets of 60 stamps (six rows of ten), the first issue on thin silky unwatermarked greyish paper made by R Turner, Chafford Mills, all line perforated.

At this period ld. was the postal rate per 1/4 lb for newspapers and for books under 1 oz.









The postal rates between countries included in the Universal Postal Union, of which the colony was now a member, were changed in 1879. The letter rate was reduced from 6d. to 4d. per 1/2 oz and this necessitated the provision of a 4d. stamp for the colony.





The proposed 5/- value was not proceeded with, as it was considered that the existing values were sufficient to meet the postal needs of this small colony at that time.

The 1882 and all following printings of values up to 1/were printed on paper made by De La Rue & Co Ltd water—
marked Crown CA. This paper normally took 240 stamps
(four sheets with ten rows of six) but the Falkland Islands
stamps were a little taller and printed in sheets of 60
stamps (six rows of ten) so the paper could be cut to give
only three sheets, the stamps becoming largely unevenly
watermarked.

In 1891 the postal rate to Great Britain and the Empire was reduced from 4d. to 2 1/2d. per 1/2 oz. There being no 1/2d. or 2 1/2d. stamps available, authority was given for bisecting the ld. stamp, each half to do duty for 1/2d., as from 1st January 1891.

On 11th January 1892 a notice was issued stating that the provisional issue was no longer in use.

In February the little hand-stamped surcharge came into use, and whole sheets were done at the post office.

Letters bearing the bisected stamp without the surcharge had it applied at the post office before despatch, but many were allowed to pass through without it.



Some unsevered pairs show a diagonal pen stroke guide line. This line was inserted at the post office and was intended to show the public how the stamps should be bisected, from top right to bottom left.





The two high values were printed on paper watermarked Crown CC in sheets of 60 stamps (six rows of ten), with the printers name in the bottom margin. There is sometimes a slight blueing of the paper.
