Björna Poststation was established on 1875-01-01 due to the krona letter carrier reform. The post office in Björna was under the postmaster in Ullånger. The collection at the post station was only SEK 153: 86 the first year. If the mail was taken once a week to Mo and again Björna Poststationen was somewhat remote from the eventually emerging railway, sometimes post offices in church villages were close to emerging railways in the danger zone, when it came to keeping the post office there, since the trains started running. It was feared that things were bad in Björna and the problem was raised at the municipal meeting in the school hall by the church on June 21, 1891. It was then made the unanimous decision "to join the King. The General Post Office with a respectful request that the post station in Björna village still measure, as hitherto may be retained here at the church, the distance from the church village to the railway station was 11,300 feet. The Post Board found at a presentation on 3 July 1891 that the petition should not give rise to respect, of which the postmaster in Sundsvall was instructed to inform the applicants, so when the northern main line was taken into use on 2 October 1891, the post station was moved to the railway station. Traffic increased so strongly that divorce between post and rail became necessary. Postexpedition 1 March 1949.

Added through the kronor letter carrier reform in 1875. The school teacher Olof Lindblom was hired as headmaster with SEK 85 in annual fee. The postmaster Daniel Janse in Örnsköldsvik did not consider the post office to be successful, since he had found that stamp sales in 1880 only amounted to SEK 92. After consultation with the Postal Board, he proposed that the postal service to Trehörningsjö should cease at the same time as the post office withdrew. The service was to be saved by the clockmaker G P Gidlund becoming a rural postman between Gideå and Trehörningsjö. The rural postmen of that time were largely just postmen but could "serve" customers who met up or lived along the route.

According to Janse's proposal, the Post Board had written to the County Administrative Board requesting approval of the proposed reorganization. Trehörningsjö Kapellbor now gathered for a meeting on December 26, 1881. It was pointed out that stamp sales had increased and that newspaper subscriptions were increasing. A sharp increase in postal traffic was expected, as "the decided country road up here from Gideå, soon enough, may be broken as early as next summer" its annual stamp sales amount to SEK 325".

In his statement, the bailiff not only emphasized this sacrifice but also the prospect "that the postal service between Gideå and Trehörningsjö, if it is offered in a renewed contract, can possibly be obtained at a cheaper price than the current one". He did not consider that the rural letter carrier would correspond to the post office's service. The county administrative board agreed to this, after which the postal board decided that the post office in Trehörningsjö would remain and that Olof Lindholm's annual fee as post office manager would be reduced to SEK 115. But with the advent of the railway, the rural post office was withdrawn and in postal matters the inhabitants had to turn to the railway station. Johan Erik Eriksson became director in December 1893. "more about the railway in the railway section"

The development was strong. Post and railway were separated and the post station was raised to a post office on October 1, 1954 With new terminology, among other things, the post office was transformed

into a local post office in 1977 with a prefabricated room abolished in 1986. The Trehörningsjö-Gideå-





Anundsjö station was opened to public traffic on October 15, 1889 and the solemn inauguration was performed by King Oscar II. Just north of the point where the railway temporarily stopped, there was a post office in Bredbyn with the parish's name Anundsjö, A representative appointed for the parish, Jan Lindström wrote on 25 September 1889 to the Post Board, among others; "Rumor has it that we have heard that after the main line opening to public traffic to Anundsjö railway station, the post office in Bredbyn will cease and that we will then have to leave and pick up our mail at the said railway station. Namely located not less than 4 kilometers from the parish capital. The current post office in Anundsjö is located at Bredbyn, about 0.5 km from Anundsjö railway station, if it is to be withdrawn, it may have to report and hand over holding effects, valuables and documents to the post office in Örnsköldsvik, under which the station currently reports, and that, if it is to be maintained it may have to be renamed. And so it became. Development was still not as positive as one might have expected. After the Second World War, it was possible to replace the post office in Anundsjö with increased postal service with increased postage with the beginning of May 1952.





The question of a post office was raised at the municipal meeting in the parish cottage on 11 January 1874, when, among other things, a need for one was stated because "opportunities to send letters, announcements etc. were reduced through the termination of Kronobrevbärningen" a decision that the post office was established fatas, With the entrance of 1875, Skorped thus got the desired post office. 

A post office was mentioned at Byvattnet, when a stopping and loading place had been built there. Its name was missing from the timetable, as it was set up quite late. The post office manager Sven Carlsson in Skorped spoke in favor of a post office in Byvattnet, despite the fact that it could have a detrimental effect on his turnover. He reported, among other things, that a loose bag was transported "daily by train from and to Byvattnet, in which all both departing and arriving daily mail is dispatched to and from the residents who would use the questioned post station". In a letter to the Postal Board on 30 December 1907, the sawmill inspector Johan Öman offered to run a post office in Byvattnet for an annual fee of SEK 200. He added; The offer does not cover more than one year at a time. In his statement to the Post Inspectorate on 30 December 1907, the postmaster in Sollefteå recommended that a post station be established at Byvattnet's stop, and in the petition to the Post Board, the Post Inspectorate agreed to this.
